3. We are now trying to clean up the open tabs, we ask that you make your payment by the 27th of each month.

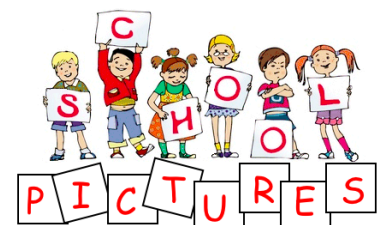

Fall Book Fair

Our annual Fall Book fair will start **Monday, October 3rd** and go thru **Thursday, October 6th**.

Times for the book fair are **8am to 5pm**. In order to get all purchases done in the evening in a timely manner, please have purchases up at the front by 5:30pm.

Book bins will be located to the left hallway passed the front desk. You and your child will get a chance to look and purchase children's books. For every book that is purchased during our book fair the school gets back 50% to spend on books for the school. The process of buying a book is very easy:

1. Look at the books and if there is one that you would like to purchase just bring it up to the front desk.
2. We will ring you up at that time. (Cost of the book plus tax). Each book has the price on the back.
3. The only form of payment for this event is **credit/debit card**.
