Transitions to New Classrooms

The first wave of transitions is complete and went very well. The next wave will begin **Monday**, **July 9th**. All the children had such a great transition, they all stayed in their new classrooms since Monday.

Look for a transition letter in your Links to Home App that will notify you of where and when your child will be transitioning to the next classroom. During transition you will still drop them off in his/her old classroom and the teacher will take them to meet the new teacher around 9:15am. The full transition into the class can take up to a week depending on the child. We start off in the morning by taking the child to visit the new room and his/her new teacher.

Your child may experience anxiety, tears, not liking school or their new teacher, all of this is normal during transition to a new classroom. Although, they may have so much fun that they will stay in the new classroom since day one. Please give the teacher a month to bond with your child; remember they will begin to establish new friendships and relationships in the new classroom.
