We have noticed that there are a LOT of children that aren't being signed out properly at pick up time. There are sign-out i-pads located at the front desk, in the infant room, and in the school-age room. Please remember to use your code to sign your children out at one of them. If you are not sure of proper procedure, keep reading below for a step by step guide or ask at the front desk and we will walk you through it.

## <u>Sign out procedure</u>

- Step 1. Pick up your child from their classroom or playground.
- Step 2. Use your unique pin # on the i-pad located at the front desk, infant room, or school-age room.
- Step 3. When your child(en)'s picture appears on the screen touch their face. This should turn the bar blue indicating that you have successfully signed out your child.



There have been a lot of things getting misplaced lately. To try to minimize this, we ask that you remember to label EVERYTHING brought into school with your child's FULL NAME. This includes: lunchboxes, water bottles, jackets, extra clothing, blankets, etc.



We have a number of different Enrichment Programs available here at Discovery Isle - La Costa. If you are interested in signing your child up for them, we have listed them below. Please remember that these programs are NOT run by Discovery Isle, but outside companies. Even though these are outside companies, we do require background checks for anyone that will be in contact with your child.

As the winter illnesses start to increase, we want to remind you of our illness policy.

Certain illnesses will require a doctor's note clearing your your child before the will be allowed to return to school.
