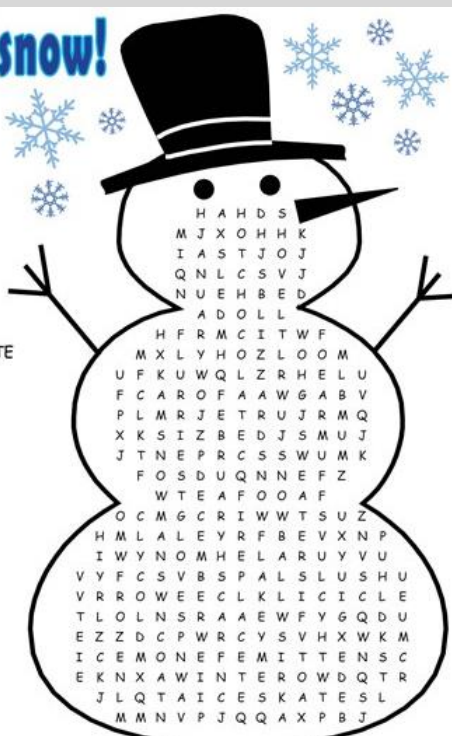
All the staff along with the admin team wants to wish each family a "Happy New Year" we are looking forward to seeing what adventures 2018 will bring.
