Just a heads up in honor of Labor Day our school will be closed on Monday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>.




### Illness Policy

Your child should not be brought to school if, within the last 24 hours, your child has had: a fever, diarrhea, a yellow or green runny nose, or other illnesses that could be given to children or teachers. Therefore, it is important that you have some kind of alternate care for your child on such occasions. The center should be notified immediately if your child has contracted one of the communicable childhood diseases such as: measles, chicken pox, hand foot and mouth, mumps, etc. We can then inform other parents of the symptoms, so they can watch for them in their children. Discovery Isle Preschool encourages safeguarding the health of young children by requesting parents to follow certain guidelines when deciding if a child is well enough to attend the center.
