# Lost & Found

### **General Rules:**

*Any child with a Fever of 100.1 or higher will be sent home & only allowed back when they are symptom free for 24 hours straight.*

*Any child with a communicable illness, (excessive cough, green goopy nose, pink eye, rash, etc.) will be sent home & only allowed back with a doctor's note.*

*Any child that has diarrhea or vomits will be sent home with or without it being accompanied by a fever & only allowed back when they are symptom free for 24 hours straight.*

The health & safety of the children in our care is our first priority. We will not send home children unless it is absolutely necessary for their health & the health of the other families and staff at our school.
