Illness Policy

With the sick season this year, we are making sure to stick closely to our illness policy in hopes of reducing the spreading of illness.

A sick child **MUST** a stay home where he or she is most comfortable. Children will be sent home if they have any of the specific symptoms listed below. The expectation is that that stay home until they are symptom free for 24 hours without the use of medications.

- ◇ Fever over 100 degrees
- ◇ Vomiting
- ◇ Diarrhea

Reminders from the classrooms:

- ◇ With our weather constantly changing, we want to make sure that our children are prepared for anything. Please make sure that back up clothing is weather appropriate.
- ◇ Cubbies: We ask that you take a look at your childs cubby to be sure they are able to place easily, their nap supplies, change of clothing and jackets.
- ◇ Make sure you are checking your child's file work weekly for artwork and any special news.
- ◇ Be sure to check your child's classroom door for any upcoming things.
- ◇ As a precaution, we ask that you write names in your child's jackets, sweaters, etc. We have many that go missing and it would help us to rehome the ones we find!
- ◇ If your child ends up borrowing clothes from the school, please be sure to return them washed and in a timely manner.
